1. Mini Contracts Consent Agenda for Action Items 4.1.1. through 4.1.6.

4.1.1. Approval of Special Education Services Contracts 2015-16

RECOMMENDED ACTION: “that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the agreements between Sachem Central School District and Central Islip Union Free School District, Connetquot School District, Longwood Central School District, Middle Country Central School District, Patchogue-Medford Union Free School District, Sayville School District, Three Village Central School District and William Floyd Union Free School District to provide special education services to parentally-placed students with disabilities, when such students attend private schools in the Sachem Central School District. Sachem CSD shall be entitled to bill these school districts for the services provided in accordance with Education Law Section 3602-c and the Regulations or Rules of the Commissioner of Education. The term of these agreements shall be from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016. These agreements have been reviewed and approved by the school district’s attorney.”

4.1.2. Approval of Special Education Services Agreement with Rockville Centre UFSD 2015-16

RECOMMENDED ACTION: “that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Rockville Centre Union Free School District to provide special education services to parentally-placed students with disabilities, when such students attend private schools in the Rockville Centre

Union Free School District, but reside in the Sachem Central School District. Rockville Centre UFSD shall be entitled to recover 100% of the actual cost of services that may be charged for each student receiving services in accordance with the Education Law and the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education. The term of this agreement shall be from September 1, 2015 through June 24, 2016.”

4.1.3. Approval of Agreement with Tams-Witmark Music Library, Inc.
