6.1. <u>Approval of Resolution for Sachem Central School District Redistricting -</u> <u>Plan 1</u>

RECOMMENDED ACTION: "that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approve the following resolution."

WHEREAS, opportunities to realize increased efficiencies within the Sachem Central School District have been under close study by the Board of Education for a number of years; and

WHEREAS, declining enrollment has been a concern of the Board for a least the past five years as the District struggles to implement costly mandates and continue its operations under the New York State property tax cap; and

WHEREAS, in view of the foregoing, pursuant to a duly adopted Board resolution, the Board of Education established the Sachem Facilities Study Committee, who, with the assistance of professionally trained experts retained by the District were charged to research and present to the Board of Education specific options and recommendations for building and district configuration during a period of declining enrollment and fiscal constraints, to ensure the efficient use of resources and support student achievement and continuous improvement of school programs, and

WHEREAS, the Board has requested and received updated demographic data, recommendations and educational impact statements regarding the closure of particular schools and redistricting options from professionally trained experts retained by the District it is hereby

RESOLVED

That the Board of Education hereby identifies Gatelot Avenue Elementary School, Tecumseh Elementary School and Sequoya Middle School as the Board of Education's agreed upon proposed school buildings for closure, and hereby directs District Administration and Counsel to take the next necessary steps to ensure further compliance with District Policy 7800 and/or Education Law 408a, including but not limited to the publication of notices to the community and elected state and local public officials who represent the affected communities that it proposes to close Gatelot Avenue Elementary School, Tecumseh Elementary School and Sequoya Middle School, and to set the final public hearing for consensus on this decision.
