

ATTENDANCE POLICY

All students must maintain 90% attendance in each class to be eligible for credit.

For each semester, a student who is absent more than FIVE (5) days in an alternating day course, or NINE (9) days in a semester course that meets every day will result in the denial of credit (DC or DCA).

An unexcused tardy to class of 15 minutes or more shall be considered for the purpose of this policy an unexcused absence.


