

A ratio is a simple relationship between two quantities: it tells us how many of one thing is present for a certain number of another thing.

Ratios can be written in three different ways. For example a ratio of 2 to 5 can be written as:

The easiest way to understand ratios is to visualize them <u>before</u> applying shortcuts. For example, if we are told that the ratio of blue marbles to red marbles is 2:5, this means that for every two <u>blue marbles</u>, there are 5 red marbles, as illustrated below.
















Blue: Red = 2:5Total = 7



An ice-cream truck driver's monthly profit can be modeled by the equation p = 2k + m + 3n, where p is the monthly profit in dollars, k is the number of ice-cream cones sold, m is the number of ice-cream sandwiches sold, and n is the number of ice pops sold.
