

ATTENDANCE POLICY

All students must maintain 90% attendance in each class to be eligible for credit.

For each semester, a student who is absent more than **FIVE (5) days** in an alternating day course, or **NINE (9) days** in a semester course that meets every day will result in the **Denial of Credit (DC or DCA**).

An unexcused tardy to class of 15 minutes or more shall be considered for the purpose of this policy an unexcused absence.
