Attendance and Early Dismissal

When you are sick or absent, please have a parent or guardian telephone the attendance office. Failure to do so will result in an illegal absence on your permanent record!

Proper ID is needed from anyone picking you up for early dismissal. Emergency cards **MUST** be filled out with the name of any person other than a parent allowed to pick you up and returned to the school for entry into the system. Failure to do so will cause delays when picking up! Under NO circumstances will you be called down before the dismissal procedure is complete.



HALLWAY S

All students should have their ID cards when in the hallway

No “Hanging Out”

Use appropriate language

Lateness to class is not tolerated – do not stop in the middle of the hallway to talk!

Sweeps - If in the hallway after the final bell:

1st time – warning

2nd time – detention

3rd time - ISS



Discipline - Point System

1/2 point for any detention issued by an Administrator

1 point per day of ISS

2 points per day for OSS



When you reach 10 points you are ineligible to participate in any extra curricular program – sporting events, field trips, evening activities, clubs, etc.

You can earn back 2 points a month if you have no further infractions.

Attendance is a reflection of your work ethic!



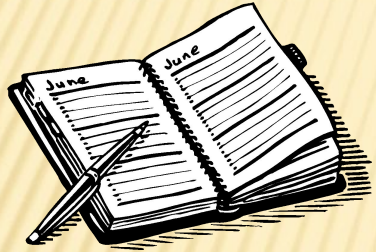
ID CARDS
