



### General Supply List

- Binder to house multiple subjects with dividers, loose leaf and folders (or two binders depending on comfort level of student)
- Casio Scientific Calculator (Except Algebra students in grade 8- they will be provided a graphing calculator)
- Pencil case or Supply box that will house the following items used in every class :
  - Pencils/Pens/Colored Pencils
  - Pencil Sharpener
  - Highlighters
  - Ruler
  - Inexpensive Earbuds with wire in a case or Ziplock bag (no Air Pods)

***Individual teachers may have specific supply requests that will not be mandated on the first day of school.***

**Backpacks** are allowed to and from school. They should be put in locker prior to period 1. Students should not carry backpacks of any size or oversized bags during the school day. Students are permitted to use standard string bags throughout the day. Optimally, students should use their locker as often as possible and only use the string bag as needed. The recent installation of new lockers will make the locker visits easier to manage!

Having no backpacks in the classrooms, cafeterias, and hallways will improve the learning environment by:

- ❖ *Decreasing the distractions commonly brought to class in backpacks (such as food, electronic devices, and other items)*
  - ❖ *Decreasing the amount materials that students carry*
  - ❖ *Provides clarity in what materials they will need for each class*
  - ❖ *Reducing tripping hazards in places such as the classrooms and cafeteria*
  - ❖ *Creating more space and mobility for all, including those with disabilities*
- ❖ *Reducing concerns regarding the ability to conceal tobacco products/ e-cigarettes, drugs or alcohol, and any dangerous items.*
