1. Approve Refunding of Bonds

RECOMMENDED ACTION: "that upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the following resolution selecting UBS Financial Services Inc., and AG Edwards & Sons, Inc as underwriters for refunding of bonds:"

WHEREAS, on September 7, 2006, the Sachem Central School District at Holbrook, in the County of Suffolk, New York (herein called "District"), adopted a resolution announcing the intention of the District to accept proposals for the refunding of certain outstanding bonds of the District, which have heretofore been issued and remain outstanding and unmatured;

Now, therefore, THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE SACHEM CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT AT HOLBROOK, IN THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK, NEW YORK, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The District received proposals from various firms for the refunding of all or a portion of the following serial bond issues of the District:

(a) \$7,200,000 School District Serial Bond-1996, which are currently outstanding in the principal amount of \$875,000;

(b) \$6,935,000 Library Building (Serial) Bonds of 1998, which are currently outstanding in the principal amount of \$5,100,000;

(c) \$50,000,000 School District Serial Bonds-2002, which are currently outstanding in the principal amount of \$45,410,000;

(d) \$75,000,000 School District Serial Bonds-2003, which are currently outstanding in the principal amount of \$70,430,000; and

(e) \$70,000,000 School District Serial Bonds-2003 Series B, which are currently outstanding in the principal amount of \$68,230,000.

and all of such proposals received have been reviewed and discussed by the District with its Financial Advisor, Capital Markets Advisors., New York, New York (the "Financial Advisor").

Section 2. Following such discussion, and based upon the written recommendation received from the Financial Advisor, the proposals of UBS Financial Services and AG Edwards & Sons, Inc. were accepted.

Section 3. The Board of Education hereby ratifies and approves the selection of UBS Financial Services and AG Edwards & Sons, Inc. to serve as underwriters in connection with the refunding of certain outstanding bonds referenced above and heretofore issued by the District.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
