#### 1. <u>Approval of Budget Transfers of \$50,000 or Greater</u>

RECOMMENDED ACTION: "Resolved, that the Board of Education approves a budget transfer of \$50,000 or greater through September 12, 2008."

#### 2. Approval of Late Transportation Requests for the 2008-09 School Year

RECOMMENDED ACTION: "that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the request for late transportation for private and parochial schools for 12 students. #### 3. <u>Approve First Choice Medical Care to Perform Physical Examinations for</u> <u>District Bus Drivers</u>

RECOMMENDED ACTION: "that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves First Choice Medical Care to perform 19A physical examinations for Sachem Central School District bus drivers. The rate per physical is \$40.00."

#### 4. <u>Approval of Funds for Robotics Team to Participate in Local Events</u>

RECOMMENDED ACTION: "that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the Robotics Team at Sachem North and East High Schools to participate in local events during the 2009 season beginning with:

- a. The FIRST Tech Challenge on September 30, 2008.

c. NYC Regional USFIRST event to be held at the Javits Center on April 2, 3, 4/09. The total cost for parts, kits and entrance fees for all three events shall not exceed \$15,000 (\$5,000 for parts, \$10,000 for entrance fees) to be paid by General Fund."

#### 5. <u>Approval of Additional Book Purchases – Harcourt School Publishers</u>

RECOMMENDED ACTION: "that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves book purchases for Special Education students in the elementary schools from Harcourt School Publishers for StoryTown 2008. The original agreement was approved at the July 30<sup>th</sup> Board of Education meeting. The cost is \$72,459.25 for fourth and fifth grade Reading books. This will be paid by Federal Funding."

## 6. <u>Approval of Donation – Memorial Garden – Sachem East Touchdown Club</u>
