1.d. <u>Approval of Agreement between Sachem School District and West Islip Union Free School</u> <u>District</u>

The term of this agreement shall be from July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009. This agreement has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

1.e. Approval of Agreement between Sachem School District and Metro Therapy, Inc.
