## 1.c. Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and Wilson Language Training Corporation

The remaining allowance is being returned to the owner. The new contract amount including this Change Order will be \$169,772.78.

#### Deduct Change Order No. 2 – SMC Construction Corp.- Seneca Middle School

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Scavo, seconded by Mr. Licata, and carried unanimously (8-0) to approve a deduct Change Order No. 2, SMC Construction Corp. for Seneca Middle School.
