ACTION ITEMS

Consent Agenda Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Timo, seconded by Mr. Duncan, and carried unanimously (7-0) to approve a consent agenda for Mini Contracts items 1a through i.

Mini Contracts

1.a Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and the Deer Park UFSD

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Timo, seconded by Mr. Duncan, and carried unanimously (7-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Deer Park Union Free School District to provide health and welfare services to students who reside in the Sachem Central School District. The rate for this service is \$677.88 per eligible pupil. The term of this agreement shall be from July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010. This agreement has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

1.b. <u>Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and Hilary Gomes,</u> <u>Ph.D. – Independent Contractor</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Timo, seconded by Mr. Duncan, and carried unanimously (7-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Hilary Gomes, Ph.D. as an independent contractor to provide neuropsychological evaluation services. The rate is \$2,500 per neuropsychological evaluation including initial consultation and history, test administration, scoring, and interpretation, feedback to parent/guardian/child, and written report. The term of this agreement is from July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2010. This contract has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

1.c. <u>Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and the Cody Center</u> <u>for Autism and Developmental Disabilities</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Timo, seconded by Mr. Duncan, and carried unanimously (7-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and the Cody Center for Autism and Developmental Disabilities to provide two (2) three hour sessions on the Needs of Children with Autism Coursework, presented by David Makowksi, Ph.D. to staff of the School District. Due to attorney review, the presentations occurred in December 2009 prior to Board of Education approval. The cost for services is \$45.00 per person attending the session. This agreement has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

1.d. <u>Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and Comsewogue</u> <u>Union Free School District</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Timo, seconded by Mr. Duncan, and carried unanimously (7-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Comsewogue Union Free School District to provide health and welfare services to students who reside in the Sachem Central School District. The rate for this service is \$475.78 per student. The term of this agreement shall be from September 9, 2009 through June 30, 2010. This agreement has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

1.e <u>Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and Music Theatre</u> <u>International (MTI)</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Timo, seconded by Mr. Duncan, and carried unanimously (7-0) to approve the agreement between the Sachem Central School District and Music Theatre International (MTI) to provide show kits and pay a royalty fee for the production of Seussical Jr. at Cayuga Elementary School. The cost is approximately \$590.00 to be paid from the Cayuga Activity Fund.

1.f. Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and Villa Lombardi's

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Timo, seconded by Mr. Duncan, and carried unanimously (7-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Villa Lombardi's for the Sachem North Tri-M Honor Society Induction Ceremony Dinner at a cost of \$28.95 per person plus applicable service charges of twenty percent (20%) to be paid by the students. The date of this function is June 7, 2010. This contract has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

1.g. <u>Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and Classic Coach</u><u>Sachem North</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Timo, seconded by Mr. Duncan, and carried unanimously (7-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Classic Coach to provide transportation services to the Sachem High School North Music Honor Society for trips to New York City on February 26, 2010 and April 21, 2010. The total cost for transportation for each trip is \$1,000.00 and will be paid by the Tri-M Music Honor Society. This contract has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

1.h. <u>Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and Music Theatre</u> <u>International (MTI)-Sagamore Middle School</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Timo, seconded by Mr. Duncan, and carried unanimously (7-0) to approve the agreement between the Sachem Central School District and Music Theatre International (MTI) for royalty fees, rental of orchestration and security fee for the production of Thoroughly Modern Millie at Sagamore Middle School on March 14 and March 15, 2010. The approximate cost of \$2,200 will be paid by the Department of Music and Fine Arts.

1.i. <u>Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and Kidsay Market</u> <u>Research Opinion Survey-Nokomis Elementary School</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Timo, seconded by Mr. Duncan, and carried unanimously (7-0) to approve student participation in a market research opinion survey between third grade Nokomis Elementary School students and Kidsay. Students will complete a survey in February entitled "What's Cool and What's Cooling Off?" about their preferences concerning entertainment, food, clothes, toys and desires. KIDSAY will provide the survey and shipping materials. Nokomis will be compensated \$3.00 per participant that completes the survey and \$.05 reimbursed per page copied. Gloria Flynn, Principal, has received prior parental consent for children participating in this survey. There is no cost to the District.

Approval of Donation – Barnes and Noble

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. LaCarrubba, seconded by Mr. Duncan, and carried unanimously (7-0) to accept with gratitude, a donation from a Barnes and Noble fundraiser held in December 2009 in the amount of \$638.37. The money will be used to purchase additional books for the library and to partially fund the drama club presentation at Cayuga Elementary School.

Approval of Donation – Woodworking Tools/Equipment – Ms. Widera

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Scavo, seconded by Mr. LaCarrubba, and carried unanimously (7-0) to accept with gratitude, the donation of various woodworking tools and equipment to the Technology Department at Sequoya Middle School from Sachem resident, Ms. Widera. The value of this donation is approximately \$2,405.00.

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Approval of Agreement and Release Between Sachem School District and Student #1003240

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Licata, seconded by Mr. Scavo, and carried unanimously (7-0) to approve the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Sachem Central School District wishes to resolve all disputes concerning a classified student known to the Board of Education for the 2008-2009 school year, and that period of time from July 1, 2009 until the time when the CSE convenes to recommend a state-approved placement at a specific school, but in any event, no later than the conclusion of the 2009-2010 school year;
