*Consent Agenda for Action Items F.1.a. through F.1.r.*

**1.a. Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and Association for the Help of Retarded Children (AHRC)**

RECOMMENDED ACTION: “that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the contract between Sachem Central School District and Association for the Help of Retarded Children (AHRC), Suffolk County Chapter, to provide for the education of handicapped children in special classes to the students enrolled in the program. The cost for this service for each child is the tuition rate set by the State Education Department. The term of this agreement shall be from July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011. This contract has been reviewed and approved by the school district’s attorney.”

**1.b. Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and Developmental Disabilities Institute**

RECOMMENDED ACTION: “that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Developmental Disabilities Institute to provide an educational program for handicapped children at the tuition rate set by the State Education Department. Psychological evaluations shall be paid at a cost of \$500 per evaluation. The term of this contract shall be from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011. This contract has been reviewed and approved by the school district’s attorney.”

**1.c. Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and The Devereux Foundation**

RECOMMENDED ACTION: “that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the agreement between Sachem Central School District and The Devereux Foundation to provide for the education of handicapped children in special classes to the students enrolled in the program. The tuition rate shall be set by the State Education Department. This contract shall be from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011. This contract has been reviewed and approved by the school district’s attorney.”

**1.d. Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and Long Island Developmental Consulting**

RECOMMENDED ACTION: “that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Long Island Developmental Consulting to provide Applied Behavior Analysis (“ABA”) methodology and techniques for special education students classified by its Committee on Special Education (“CSE”). Consultations shall include, but not be limited to Functional Behavior Assessments, Behavior Intervention Plans, Behavior Modification Systems, Curriculum Modification, Material Modification, Evaluations, Staff Development, Home Program Services, Supervision of Home Staff and Parent Training Services. The school district shall pay the rates listed in Appendix A, Rate Schedule. This is included in the Office of Student Services budget. This agreement shall be in effect for the period July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011. This contract has been reviewed and approved by the school district’s attorney.”

**1.e. Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and Island Photography**

RECOMMENDED ACTION: “that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the agreement between Island Photography and Sachem Central School District for the Sachem High School North Graduation Ceremony in June 2011. There is no cost to the school district for this service.”

**1.f. Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and Hilary Gomes, Ph.D – Independent Contractor**

**1.h. Approval of Addendum to the 2009-10 Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and the Smithtown Central School District**

RECOMMENDED ACTION: “that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves an addendum to the 2009-10 agreement between Sachem Central School District and Smithtown CSD to provide special education services to parentally-placed students with disabilities, when such students attend private schools in the Smithtown Central School District. #### 10. **Approval of Budget Transfers Greater Than \$50,000**

As you can see a large portion of this transfer is due to Workers’ Compensation expenses. This was due to large indemnity settlements paid during the 2009-2010 school year.
- The fifth and sixth transfers for \$8,688,306 and \$5,864,811 are to re-class 2009-2010 ARRA ESF funding into separate budget codes as prescribed by the NYS Comptroller.
