#### 1.a. <u>Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and</u> <u>Association for the Help of Retarded Children (AHRC)</u>

RECOMMENDED ACTION: "that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the contract between Sachem Central School District and Association for the Help of Retarded Children (AHRC), Suffolk County Chapter, to provide for the education of handicapped children in special classes to the students enrolled in the program. The cost for this service for each child is the tuition rate set by the State Education Department. The term of this agreement shall be from July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011. This contract has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney."

#### 1.b. <u>Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and</u> <u>Developmental Disabilities Institute</u>

# 10. Approval of Budget Transfers Greater Than \$50,000

- One transfer for \$231,124 is to reclassify four mechanics performing EXCEL Bond work.

- The fifth and sixth transfers for \$8,688,306 and \$5,864,811 are to re-class 2009-2010 ARRA ESF funding into separate budget codes as prescribed by the NYS Comptroller.
