## b. <u>Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and Dr. Donna</u> <u>Geffner</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. LaCarrubba, seconded by Mr. Tripi, and carried unanimously (8-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Dr. Donna Geffner as an independent contractor to provide speech therapy services. #### e. <u>Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and Special</u> <u>Education Services-Eastport South Manor</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. LaCarrubba, seconded by Mr. Tripi, and carried unanimously (8-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Eastport South Manor Central School District to provide special education and related services to students with disabilities, when such students attend schools in the Eastport South Manor Central School District. Eastport South Manor

CSD shall be entitled to bill Sachem CSD in accordance with Part 174 of the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education. The term of this agreement shall be from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011. This agreement has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

## f. Approval of Agreement between the Sachem Central School District and Jim Wright

Thereafter, Mr. Lederman shall receive twenty-two (22) days full pay commencing 11/22/10 in accordance with the District's military leave policy and in accordance with §242 et. seq. of the Military Law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Mr. Lederman will be entitled to any and all other benefits and rights as set forth in Board Policy 9520.3.

\*Dates are based upon his military orders, yet to be received as of 10/20/10.
