CALL TO ORDER:	The regular meeting held at Samoset Middle School was called to order by President Scavo at 7:30pm.
PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:	President Scavo opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silent meditation.
MINUTES:	Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a Motion was made by Mr. Timo, seconded by Mr. Licata, and carried unanimously (8-0) to approve the following minutes: October 6, 2010 – Work Session October 13, 2010 – Special Meeting October 20, 2010 – Regular Meeting
STATEMENT:	 President Scavo read the following statement: At the October 20, 2010 meeting, the Board of Education accepted the resignation of Mr. David Egloff, who served as a Board of Education trustee for the past year and a half. As a result of this resignation, the Board of Education discussed the legal responsibilities of fulfilling the vacated seat as well as the different methods that may be used under State Education Law. The methods to fulfill a vacated seat allowed under state law include: A special election which would have cost the district approximately \$60,000 The selection of a new trustee appointed by the Superintendent of the local Board of Cooperative Educational Services also known as BOCES.
	• An appointment of a trustee to be selected by the Sachem Board of Education.

As a result of the discussion on the legal options to fulfill the vacated

seat, the Board of Education decided to appoint a member of the community. The Board agreed that there would be set criteria for a candidate to be considered for the vacant seat. The applicants had to be an active member of a Board of Education advisory committee or a candidate that ran for a trustee seat at the last election held in May 2010. Furthermore, applicants were required to submit their resume and a letter of intent no later than October 27th to be considered for the trustee appointment.

We received seven resumes from community members, each of which was highly qualified and well experienced in various areas. The resumes were forwarded to all of the Board members to review so that a discussion and a decision could be made at the following meeting. On November 6th, a lengthy discussion was held in executive session mainly focusing on the strengths of the candidates and how their work experience, advisory committee experience and expertise would best serve as a Board of Education member. This was a very difficult decision for the Board since every applicant that submitted a letter of intent would have been an excellent choice and a productive Board member. As a result of the discussion, the Board of Education decided that the candidate to be appointed to fulfill the vacant seat is Mr. Michael Isernia.

Mr. Michael Isernia attended Sachem Schools from kindergarten through 12th grade and graduated from Sachem North in 1981. He has been an active member of the Budget Advisory Committee for the past two years where he reviewed and provided the Board with recommendations on food service revenues, community education revenues, swim programs, allocation of unappropriated fund balance as well as other numerous charges. Mr. Isernia currently services as the Vice Chair of the BAC.

Prior to serving on the Budget Advisory Committee, Mr. Isernia also served as the secretary of the Capital Projects Advisory Committee. His responsibilities included the screening and interviews of potential architectural firms and construction management companies for the EXCEL Bond Proposal. He worked as part of a team to identify potential capital projects and prioritized them as per the Board's request.

Over the past several years, Mr. Isernia has volunteered a tremendous amount of time is designing and constructing the scenery for many plays and drama productions at both Seneca Middle School as well as Sachem North High School.

On behalf of the entire Board of Education, I would like to publicly thank all of the candidates that submitted their resumes for consideration for the Board Trustee position. You know that you live in a special place when seven community members, given very short notice, offer to volunteer their time and energy for the purpose of improving the educational experiences of our children. It gives me great pleasure to welcome and congratulate Mr. Michael Isernia on his appointment to the Board of Education and we look forward to working with Mr. Isernia on achieving the board of Education District goals.
