a. **Approval of Agreement Between the Sachem Central School District and Pathfinder Village**

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Ms. Lampitelli, seconded by Mr. Isernia, and carried unanimously (7-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Pathfinder Village to provide adequate instruction, related services and/or a facility to students receiving services. The tuition rate will be set by the State Education Department.

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The term of this agreement shall be from July 1, 2012 to June 30, 2013. This agreement has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

b. **Approval of Agreement Between the Sachem Central School District and PM Productions**

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Ms. Lampitelli, seconded by Mr. Isernia, and carried unanimously (7-0) to approve the agreements between PM Productions and Sachem Central School District for disc jockey entertainment services for the Sagamore Middle School Dance on April 12, 2013 for a fee of \$400.00 and the 8<sup>th</sup> grade formal on June 7, 2013 for a fee of \$500.00 for a total cost of \$900.00. This agreement has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

c. **Approval of Agreement Between the Sachem Central School District and Special Education Providers for Section 611 and Section 619 Grants**

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Ms. Lampitelli, seconded by Mr. Isernia, and carried unanimously (7-0) to approve the agreements for receipt of IDEA Flow-Through Funding between Sachem Central School District and Ascent: A School for Individuals with Autism, Just Kids Early Childhood Learning Center, Marion K. Salomon & Associates, Inc., Maryhaven, Mountain Lake Academy as special education providers for the 611 and 619 grants. The costs associated are in accordance with the IDEA section 611 and section 619 federal funds consistent with federal and state statutes. The term of these agreements shall be September 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013 for a ten (10) month program or July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013 for a twelve (12) month program. These contracts have been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.
