> Proposition No. 1: Shall the following proposition be adopted: RESOLVED, that the budget for the SACHEM CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT, Suffolk County, New York, for the fiscal year 2013-2014 in the amount of \$293,041,954 as proposed by the Board of Education in accordance with Section 1716 of the Education Law, shall be approved, a tax levied therefor upon the taxable property of said School District. Adoption of this budget requires a tax levy increase of \$6,866,133 that exceeds the statutory tax levy increase limit of 3.14% for the 2013-2014 school year and, therefore, exceeds the New York State tax levy limit including exemptions by 4.35% and must be approved by 60 percent of the qualified voters present and voting.
