a. Approval of Agreement with Metro Therapy, Inc. 2014-15

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Tripi, seconded by Mr. Isernia, and carried unanimously (8-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Metro Therapy, Inc. to provide therapy services to designated students at the rates set forth in Appendix "A". b. <u>Approval of Managed Services Agreement with Eastern Suffolk BOCES in Conjunction with Centris</u> <u>Group, LLC 2013-14</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Tripi, seconded by Mr. Isernia, and carried unanimously (8-0) to approve the Managed Services Agreement between Sachem Central School District and Eastern Suffolk BOCES in conjunction with Centris Group, LLC for access and use of its software. The total cost for 2013-2014 is \$40,372.00 which includes I.E.P. Direct renewal software license and support services and NYSE Directors renewal. This agreement has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

c. Approval of Agreement with The Fresh Air Fund-Sharpe Reservation

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Tripi, seconded by Mr. Isernia, and carried unanimously (8-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and the Fresh Air Fund-Sharpe Reservation. The Sachem High School North Football Team will be attending the camp from August 24, 2014 through August 29, 2014. The cost of this trip for the students is paid by fund raisers and the Sachem High School North Touchdown Club.

d. Approval of Subscription Agreement with eSchoolData, LLC 2014-15

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Tripi, seconded by Mr. Isernia, and carried unanimously (8-0) to approve the subscription agreement between Sachem Central School District and eSchoolData, LLC, a student management system that stores all student information such as transcripts, progress reports, etc. The 2014-15 annual subscription licensing renewal fee is \$153,939.60 for 14,020 students based on \$10.98 per student fee. The SQL Database Downloader service fee is \$2,500.00. All minor and major upgrades, state reporting and auto downloaders are automatically updated in the eSchoolData Student Management System at no charge.

e. Approval of Agreement with SCO Family of Services/Tyree Learning Center 2014-15

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Tripi, seconded by Mr. Isernia, and carried unanimously (8-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and SCO Family of Services/Tyree Learning Center to provide adequate instruction, related services and/or a facility to students enrolled at the facility during the school year. Sachem School District shall pay the applicable tuition rate set by the State Education Department, based on the child's program. This agreement shall be in effect for the period July 1, 2014 to June 30, 2015. This contract has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

f. <u>Approval of Health and Welfare Service Agreement with Northport-East Northport UFSD 2013-14</u>
