Mini Contracts

a. Approval of Health and Welfare Service Agreement with East Islip SD 2014-15

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Ms. Ahearn, seconded by Mr. Isernia, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and East Islip School District to provide health and welfare services to students who reside in Sachem Central School District. The rate for this service is \$898.92 per student. The term of this agreement shall be from September 4, 2014 through June 30, 2015. This agreement has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

b. <u>Approval of Agreement with School Aid Specialists 2015-16</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Ms. Ahearn, seconded by Mr. Isernia, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and School Aid Specialists to review our current and prior year financial and student records for all applicable funding years as part of its revenue recovery service. They will prepare or assist staff with any correspondence, STAC forms, BEDS data, SA-100/ST-3 revisions or other communications needed to effectuate any such findings and provide staff training and recommendations. The District agrees to pay \$30,650.00 to be paid in two (2) equal installments on December 1, 2015 and June 30, 2016 respectively. This agreement shall be in effect for the period July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016. This contract has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

c. <u>Approval of Agreement with St. James Tutoring 2015-16</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Ms. Ahearn, seconded by Mr. Isernia, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and St. James Tutoring to provide home teaching and related services in accordance with the State Education regulations, using only teachers certified by the New York State Education Department. The

rate for home teaching is \$45.00 per hour, per student. This contract shall be in effect from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016. This contract has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

d. Approval of Agreement with Mountain Lake Academy 2015-16

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Ms. Ahearn, seconded by Mr. Isernia, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Mountain Lake Academy to provide adequate instruction, related services and/or a facility to students enrolled at the facility during the school year. The cost for each child is the tuition rate set by the State Education Department. The term of this agreement shall be from July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016. This contract has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

e. <u>Approval of Agreement with Reach for the Stars Tutoring, Inc. 2015-16</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Ms. Ahearn, seconded by Mr. Isernia, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Reach for the Stars Tutoring, Inc. to provide academic tutoring services in accordance with the State Education regulations, using only teachers certified by the New York State Education Department. The fee for tutoring services is \$41.00 per hour. The term of this agreement is July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016. This contract has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.

f. <u>Approval of Agreement with Island Tutoring Center 2015-16</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Ms. Ahearn, seconded by Mr. Isernia, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Island Tutoring Center to provide home teaching and related services in accordance with the State Education regulations, using only teachers certified by the New York State Education Department. The rates are as follows:

g. Approval of Agreement with LI Neuropsychological Consultants 2015-16

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Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Ms. Ahearn, seconded by Mr. Isernia, and carried unanimously (9-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Mill Neck Manor School for the Deaf to provide adequate instruction, related services and/or a

facility to students during the school year. Sachem School District shall pay for each child the per pupil charge (PPC) set by the Commissioner of the New York State Education Department. The term of this agreement shall be from July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016. This contract has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney.
