VII. ACTION ITEMS**1. Mini Contracts Consent Agenda for Action Items 7.1.1. through 7.1.13.****7.1.1. Approval of Maintenance Agreements with Apperson Education Products 2015-16**

RECOMMENDED ACTION: “that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the maintenance agreements between Sachem Central School District and Apperson Education Products for district-wide scantron machines which include repairs to restore equipment to proper working order in the event of equipment failure. Apperson shall make adjustments and repairs, supply loaner machines until repairs are completed, and replace parts as deemed appropriate to place equipment in good working condition. The cost is \$13.25 per month for each scantron machine for a total cost not to exceed \$7,632.00 for the 2015/16 school year.”

7.1.2. Approval of Special Education Services Agreement with Eastport South Manor CSD 2015-16

RECOMMENDED ACTION: “that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Eastport/South Manor Central School District to provide special education and related services to students with disabilities, when such students attend schools in the Eastport South Manor Central School District. 7.1.3. Approval of Health and Welfare Service Agreement with Smithtown CSD 2014-15

RECOMMENDED ACTION: “that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Smithtown Central School District to provide health and welfare services to students who reside in the Sachem Central School District. The rate for these services is \$836.21 per student. The term of this agreement shall be from September 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015. This agreement has been reviewed and approved by the school district’s attorney.”

7.1.4. Approval of Health and Welfare Services Agreement with Rockville Centre UFSD 2014-15

RECOMMENDED ACTION: “that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Rockville Centre Union Free School District to provide health and welfare services to students who reside in the Sachem Central School District. The rate for this service is \$1,301.00 per student for the 2014-15 school year. This agreement has been reviewed and approved by the school district’s attorney.”

7.1.5. Approval of Health and Welfare Services Agreement with Commack UFSD 2014-15

RECOMMENDED ACTION: “that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Commack Union Free School District to provide health and welfare services to students who reside in the Sachem Central School District. The rate for this service is \$976.16 per student for the 2014-15 school year. This agreement has been reviewed and approved by the school district’s attorney.”

7.1.6. Approval of Agreement with Mazz Marketing, Inc. 2015-16

RECOMMENDED ACTION: “that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Mazz Marketing, Inc. to provide a one day seminar on October 20, 2015, or such other date mutually agreed upon by the parties during the 2015-16 school year to the parents, students and staff of Sachem High School East concerning the college athletic recruiting process. The fee for this service is \$850.00. The term of the agreement shall be for the period from October 1, 2015 to October 31, 2015. This contract has been reviewed and approved by the school district’s attorney.”

7.1.7. Approval of Agreement with Bayada Home Health Care Skilled Nursing Services - Busing Only 2015-16

RECOMMENDED ACTION: “that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Bayada Home Health Care to provide an RN to care for the students each day that they ride to and from school on the bus. Nursing services will be provided subject to the availability of a qualified nurse. The services to be provided include, escorting students to and from school on the bus. The cost is \$55.00 per hour for R.N. services. This agreement shall be in effect for the period July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016. This contract has been reviewed and approved by the school district’s attorney.”

7.1.8. Approval of Maintenance Agreement with Precision Microproducts of America, Inc. 2015-16

RECOMMENDED ACTION: “that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the maintenance agreement for Precision Microproducts of America, Inc. to provide maintenance on two Microfiche Readers, one at Sachem High School North and one in the Payroll Office, at a total cost of \$1,280.00. This is to be paid through the General Fund by the Business Office and Sachem High School North. This agreement shall be in effect from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016.”

7.1.9. Approval of Agreement with Reviewed Costs, Inc. D/B/A Industrial U.I. Services 2015-16

The fee for this service is \$8,000.00 in four (4) equal installments of \$2,000.00 to be paid quarterly. This agreement has been reviewed and approved by the school district’s attorney.”

7.1.10. Approval of Questar III Fund Surplus Resolution Agreement and Release

RECOMMENDED ACTION: “that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the Fund Surplus Resolution Agreement and Release between Sachem Central School District and the Board of Cooperative Educational Services Rensselaer - Columbia - Greene Counties (Questar III). Questar III will return to the District a total of \$1,753.53, which by this agreement shall be deemed to constitute the District’s full and complete entitlement to its share of the Other Post-Employment Benefits (OPEB) accrual amount. Questar III is now liquidating OPEB accumulations in accordance with the plan. This resolution and agreement has been reviewed and approved by the school district’s attorney.”

7.1.11. Approval of Agreement with Camp Kennybrook 2015

RECOMMENDED ACTION: “that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Camp Kennybrook for the use of the following facilities for the football program from August 23, 2015 through August 28, 2015:

- Bunks to house the students and staff and fifteen meals
- Athletic Fields
- Meeting area for practice during inclement weather and evenings

- Use of the pool at designated times
The cost of this trip will be paid for by fundraisers and the Sachem High School East Touchdown Club. This contract has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney."

7.1.12. Approval of Agreement with Sachem Youth Soccer League, Inc. 2015-2025

RECOMMENDED ACTION: "that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Sachem Youth Soccer League, Inc. to lease the Waverly Avenue Fields located at 111 Waverly Avenue, Holtsville, New York to be used and occupied only for the operation of its community athletic group. The annual rent for the period April 1, 2015 to March 31, 2016 is the sum of \$5000.00 in twelve equal monthly installments of \$416.67 commencing on the 1st day of April 2015 and each and every month thereafter during said period. In addition to the rental payment, the lessee agrees to perform, over the course of the term of the agreement, at least \$60,000 in improvements to the premises. For each subsequent year of the agreement, the annual rent shall be increased by two percent (2%) or the Consumer Price Index for N.Y. The term of the agreement shall be for ten (10) years from April 1, 2015 through March 31, 2025. This agreement has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney."

7.1.13. Approval of Amendment to Agreement of Sale with 245 Union Avenue LLC

RECOMMENDED ACTION: "that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the amendment to the agreement of sale between Sachem Central School District and 245 Union Avenue LLC for the purchase price of \$3.5 million. This contract has been reviewed and approved by the school district's attorney."

JOINT MUNICIPAL COOPERATIVE BIDDING PROGRAM**

RECOMMENDED ACTION: "that, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education approves the following resolution:"

WHEREAS, various educational and municipal corporations located within the State of New York desire to bid jointly for generally needed services and standardized supply and equipment items; and

WHEREAS, the *SACHEM CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT*, an educational/municipal corporation (hereinafter the “Participant”) is desirous of selectively participating with other educational and/or municipal corporations in the State of New York in joint bidding in the areas mentioned above pursuant to General Municipal Law § 119-o and Education Law Section 1950; and

WHEREAS, the Participant is a municipality within the meaning of General Municipal Law § 119-n and is eligible to participate in the Board of Cooperative Educational Services, First Supervisory District of Suffolk County (hereinafter Eastern Suffolk BOCES) Joint Municipal Cooperative Bidding Program (hereinafter the “Program”) in the areas mentioned above; and

WHEREAS, the Participant acknowledges receipt of the Program description inclusive of Eastern Suffolk BOCES’ standard bid packet and the general conditions relating to said Program; and

WHEREAS, with respect to all activities conducted by the Program, the Participant wishes to delegate to Eastern Suffolk BOCES the responsibility for drafting of bid specifications, advertising for bids, accepting and opening bids, tabulating bids, awarding the bids, and reporting the results to the Participant.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Participant hereby appoints Eastern Suffolk BOCES to represent it and to act as the lead agent in all matters related to the Program as described above; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Participant hereby authorizes Eastern Suffolk BOCES to place all legal advertisements for any required cooperative bidding in Newsday, which is designated as the official newspaper for the Program; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a Participant Meeting shall be held annually consisting of a representative from each Program Participant. Notice of the meeting shall be given to each representative at least five (5) days prior to such meeting; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an Advisory Committee will be formed consisting of five to ten representatives of Program Participants for a term of three (3) years as authorized by General Municipal Law §119-o.2.j.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Agreement with the Participant shall be for a term of one (1) year as authorized by General Municipal Law §119-o.2.j.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Participant agrees to pay Eastern Suffolk BOCES an annual fee as determined annually by Eastern Suffolk BOCES to act as the lead agent for the Program.
