# a. <u>Approval of Agreement with Tams-Witmark Music Library, Inc.</u>

Mr. Coggin, and carried unanimously (6-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Tams-Witmark Music Library, Inc. for the rentals, royalties and full orchestration for the production of Bye Bye Birdie at Sachem High School East. The total cost of \$2,140.00 will be paid by the District Office for Music and Art.

### b. Approval of Special Education Services Agreement with Middle Country CSD 2015-16

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Tripi, seconded by Mr. Coggin, and carried unanimously (6-0) to approve the agreement between Sachem Central School District and Middle Country CSD to provide special education services to parentally-placed students with disabilities, when such students attend private schools in the Middle Country CSD, but reside in Sachem Central School District. Middle Country CSD shall be entitled to bill Sachem CSD in accordance with Education Law Section 3602-c and the Regulations or Rules of the Commissioner of Education. The term of this agreement shall be from July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016.

#### c. <u>Approval of License Agreement with RH Theatricals</u>

Upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools, a **Motion** was made by Mr. Tripi, seconded by Mr. Coggin, and carried unanimously (6-0) to approve the license agreement between Sachem Central School District and RH Theatricals to provide a production pack for the production of The Sound of Music Jr. at Seneca Middle School.
